Our Program:

Kathy Olmstead presented a program on Tommy's Place. "Tommy" is Tommy Olmstead who is an Associate Chaplain at the Branch County Jail. Following tragic endings, for a couple of women she had worked with at the jail after their release, she determined that a transitional facility to help women readjust and re-enter society would be a good idea.

Some of the support the residents receive includes:

- A faith based program with 24 hour supervision.
- Rehabilitation programs that include: Spiritual guidance, personal counselling, 12 step program, job skills, practical life skills, personal hygiene

It is a safe and sober environment where members share responsibilities in the care of the home. Together women support and encourage individual growth while learning how to live without drugs and alcohol. They develop community with each other that promotes healthy living and sobriety.

Ribbon cutting on new home is on December 3. They have people ready to move in now. Women do not have to be coming out of jail to participate due to alcohol or drug addiction. The cost is \$30 per day with an expected stay of 90 days.
