Our Program:

Larry Carlson, Chairman & Co-Founder, of Youth Haven Ranch presented a program today that discussed their focus on disadvantaged kids. They are a non-denominational Christian organization that uses the Bible and scripture in teaching. Larry began warming up his audience by playing tunes on his electronic accordion!! We know this because he had to "reboot" the computer....

- They were founded in 1968 by the Carlson family. Their main location is on 390 acres in Rives Junction with 30 year-round buildings, and they opened a location in Arizona in 1982, with 85 acres and 12 year-round buildings.
- Eligible children are between the ages of 7-13, and may typically include those in foster care, single-parent homes, or low-income homes. Each year, over 3,000 come to Youth Haven in Michigan and Arizona.
- Children are either referred to Youth Haven by an agency, such as social services, child welfare agencies, schools, or community groups. Individuals may refer a child that may need assistance.
- Programs are offered year-round with weekend programs during the school year and 1-2 week summer camps. Children are provided food, clothing and a safe place to play. The children come with much emotional baggage at a time when they are robbed of their youth. There is no charge for the child to attend.

After the program Larry was presented a check from the Club as part of our annual support of Youth Haven Ranch and their meaningful programs for children.
